## How to use this Journal

This journal is your personal record of encounters with insect messengers. Each time an insect captures your attention, appears repeatedly, or shows up during significant moments, take time to document the experience. Over time, patterns will emerge that reveal deeper spiritual guidance.

- Write as soon as possible after an encounter while details are fresh
- Trust your first intuitive impressions
- Be honest about your feelings and reactions
- Look for patterns monthly and seasonally
- Remember: there are no "wrong" interpretations - your personal connection is what matters

- **Feelings:** Your emotional response
- **Life situation:** What's happening in your life
- **Message:** What wisdom this creature brings
